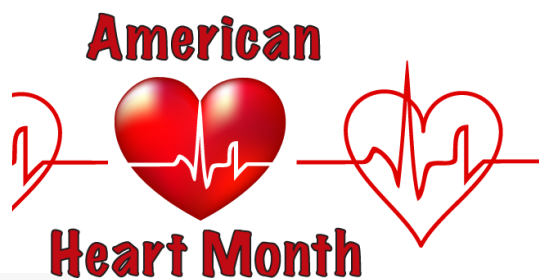

Covid-19 Vaccine Information Highlights

The Department of Health in Manatee County is offering vaccinations to full– or part-time Florida residents aged 65 and older by appointment only, as supply is available. You need to sign up for a standby pool spot, and the workers call you to set up your appointment time. You will need to fill out a consent form, which you can download from a link at the site listed below. You must be available for the second dose 28 days later. Proof of Florida residency and proper identification are required, and if you don't have a Florida license you will need two of the following:

- ◆ Mortgage info or lease agreement, (which you can pick up here in the Office)
- ◆ Utility bill not more than two months old
- ◆ Mail from a financial institution, such as statements, not more than two months old
- ◆ Mail from a government agency, not more than two months old.

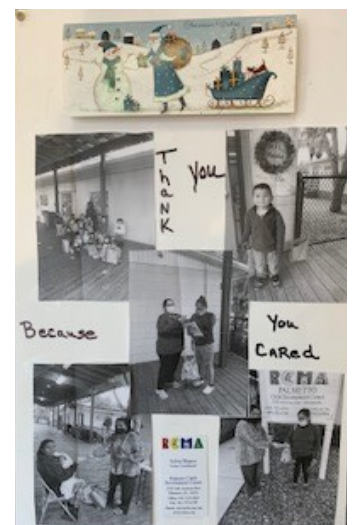

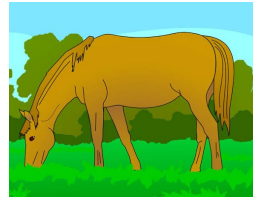

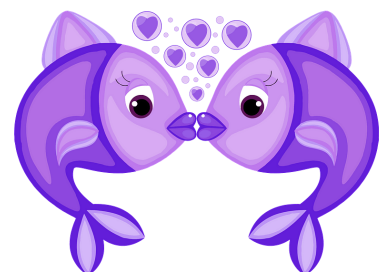
